The Catholic Church asks its members, ages 18-60, to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, unless a physical condition prevents otherwise. This means only one full meal is permitted. Small quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be eaten between meals.

The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence, meaning meat is not permitted. Abstinence is required of those age 14 and older.

DIOCESE OF MADISON 2010 ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL UNDERWAY

All registered parishioners have received a mailing from Bishop Morlino asking for a pledge to the 2010 Annual Catholic Appeal.

The budget for the diocesan portion of the Annual Catholic Appeal has been lowered to \$2.7 million.

As a result, once the diocesan budget is met, the next \$730,000 will be made available to help with local Catholic schools, Religious education programs, distressed parishes and the work of Catholic Charities. These priorities have been expressed to the Bishop by parish, school and Catholic Charities leaders.
