DIVINE MERCY

Divine Mercy Sunday will be celebrated on April 11 at St. Aloysius Church. The festivities will begin with a welcome and introduction at 12:30pm in the St. Aloysius School gym. This will be followed by a procession with the Divine Mercy Image to the Church. Featured speakers, music, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, the Rosary, Eucharistic Adoration and Confession will continue in the Church, with Mass celebrated by Bishop Robert Morlino at 4:00pm.
