I'll try to catch up as soon as possible. It was indeed a hectic week, but a beautiful week too. The ordinations were just wonderful. We have three more priests in our diocese from the Society of Jesus Christ the Priest, and even though Fr. Osvaldo is going to work to Chile with Bishop Morlino's permission, the other two are staying in our diocese. Right now they are waiting for an official assignment from the Bishop, but meanwhile they will help out in our cluster. Since Fr. Jared is gone now for a month both of them will be filling in for him. I have always said that Fr. Jared works so much that he needs two priests to substitute for him.

The first Masses that the newly ordained said were also very beautiful. Fr. John Blewett's first High Solemn Mass was just breathtaking. I have to congratulate the Traditional Latin Mass choir. Their singing was angelical. They had been practicing hard since Easter for that Mass, every Thursday for two hours. It was worth it. The music was spectacular. St. Norbert's people were there to help out, as efficiently as always, and even though there was a brief moment of panic when it seemed that the punch had ran out, the situation went back to normal as soon as the punch was found (there was no need of a miracle). I am proud to see all the parishes working together and collaborating in so many projects. I think our cluster is a role model of cooperation and unity.

On another note, I also wanted to thank the parish for the way it has welcomed the Consecrated Women. They have moved out temporarily while the rectory is being renovated to expand the upstairs bathroom and replace some of the plumbing. The rectory is a good building, but it hasn't being renovated since it was built. While the rest of the Consecrated Women are waiting for their visas we will use this window of opportunity accommodate the house for them.
