As you can see, the top three choices are Mary, Mother of Mercy Parish, Our Lady of Angels Parish, and Our Lady of Lourdes Parish. These names reflect our devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, our heavenly patroness and protector, and our desire to honor her under different titles and aspects.

The transition team will submit these three names to Bishop Hying, who will make the final decision on the name of our future parish. We trust that the Holy Spirit will guide him in this process, and we pray for his wisdom and discernment.

We expect to receive the bishop's announcement by the end of February, and we will share it with you as soon as possible. We look forward to celebrating our new identity as a united parish, and we thank you for your patience and cooperation.

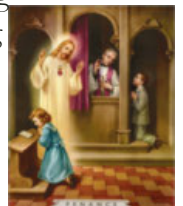
