

Dear Parishioners,

I am pleased to share that our pastorate has officially submitted applications for the Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP), a federal program administered by FEMA that helps houses of worship and religious schools strengthen their security against potential threats.

In recent years, we have all become more aware of the unfortunate rise in incidents targeting religious institutions across our country. This grant program exists precisely to address that reality, offering funding for security improvements such as cameras, access control systems, emergency notification systems, and security lighting. These measures help ensure that our churches and schools remain safe places for worship, learning, and community life.


Behind these applications was a significant amount of work. Over the course of the last four days alone, the committee dedicated more than eleven hours to completing and submitting the required paperwork. That effort was preceded by extensive preparation, including detailed vulnerability assessments for each of our sites. This was careful, methodical work, done with the long-term safety of our parish family in mind.

We submitted applications for seven facilities across our pastorate: St. Aloysius Church, St. Aloysius School, and St. Mary, Health of the Sick Church (Divine Mercy Parish); St. Norbert Church, St. Norbert Rectory, and Shoreless Lake School Wisconsin (St. Norbert Parish); and St. Barnabas Church (Holy Cross Parish). The total funding requested is \$1,026,925.

I am deeply grateful to those who served on the committee and made this possible: Nathan Hutter, Bob Koch, Daniela Saldaña, and Peggy Kruchten. Their generosity with their time, expertise, and patience made an enormous difference. This is one of those quiet but essential works of stewardship that often happens behind the scenes, yet benefits everyone.

Grant awards are competitive and will be announced later this year. I ask for your prayers that our applications are successful. If awarded, these funds would allow us to make meaningful safety improvements without placing an additional financial burden on our parishes. Regardless of the outcome, please know that the safety of our parishioners, students, and staff remains a priority.


