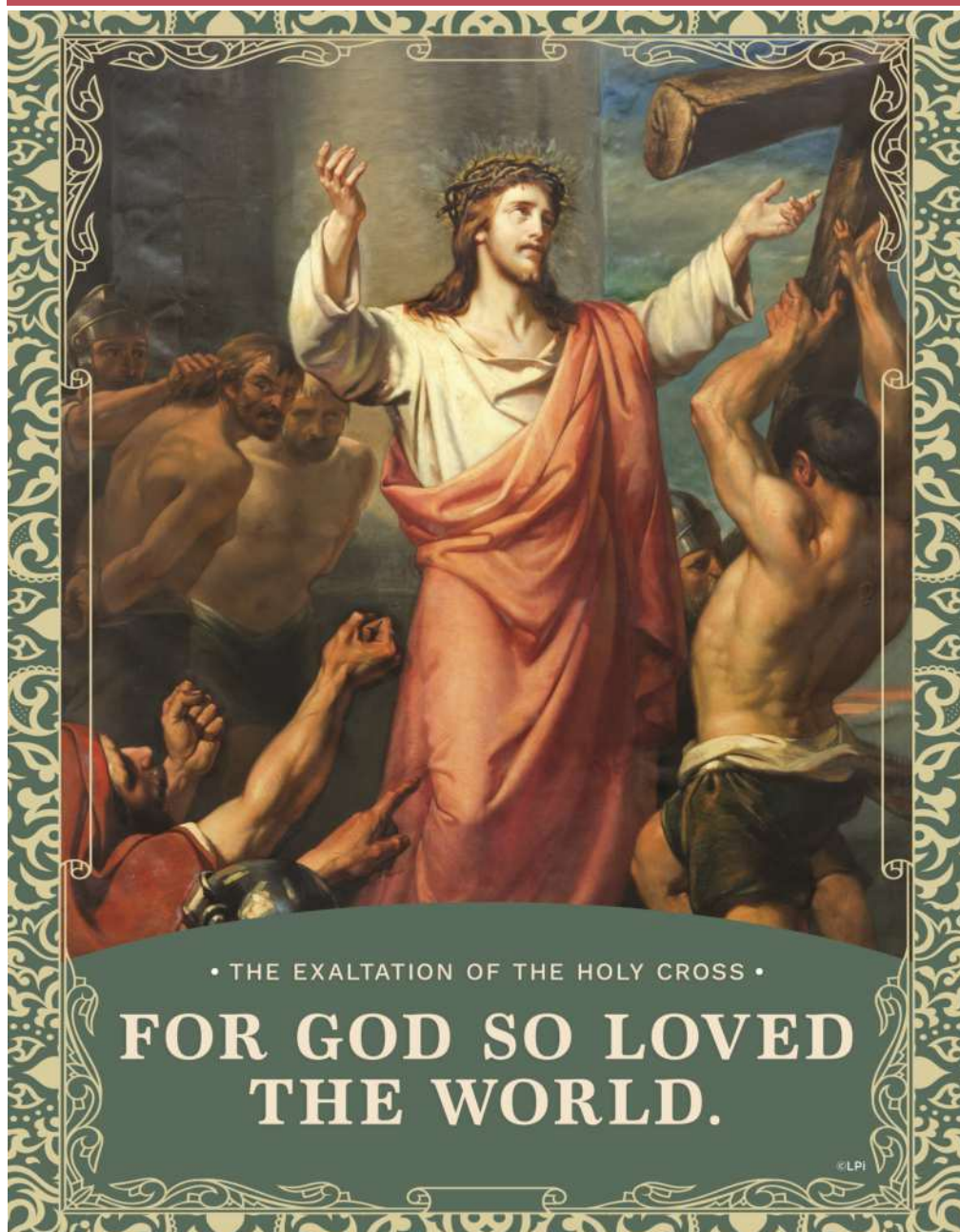

Dear Parishioners,

This coming Wednesday, September 17th, marks the beginning of our pastorate Religious Education program for the year! We are excited to welcome our families back as we embark on another year of learning and growing in our love for the Lord.

We are all called to continually form ourselves in the Faith. Faith is not a static subject we master once as children; it is a living gift from God. Like any living thing, it requires our active participation and care. We must practice it through prayer and good works, and we must constantly seek to deepen our knowledge of God and His mysteries. If we neglect our faith, it risks drying up and withering away.

Parents, you are the first and most important teachers of your children in the ways of faith. This sacred duty is fulfilled not just with words, but most powerfully through your example. We encourage you to bring your family to Mass every Sunday and on all Holy Days of Obligation. Be a powerful witness to your children by receiving the sacraments frequently, especially the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession). In a world full of distractions, the most precious inheritance you can pass on is a vibrant and living relationship with Jesus Christ, which will guide them to Heaven.

Do not be content with just going to church on Sundays. Our Faith must be lived and it must grow. If our relationship with Christ is something merely formalistic, it will die. We must actively seek Him out in our daily lives. Find time to pray as a family, strive to imitate our Lord in your actions, and work intentionally to grow in the virtues.

Our pastorate is committed to supporting you in this mission. This is our third year of the Families of Faith program, a model that involves the entire family in the formation process. This year, our curriculum will focus on the moral life, exploring what it means to live the way God wants us to live. From the Ten Commandments to the Beatitudes and the Great Commandment, we will see how God, throughout salvation history, has provided us with a clear path for living virtuously.

Ultimately, God sent us the perfect model of holiness in His own Son. Jesus Christ shows us what a life lived for the Father looks like, and He calls each of us to live like Him and in Him. We look forward to journeying with your family this year as we answer that call together.

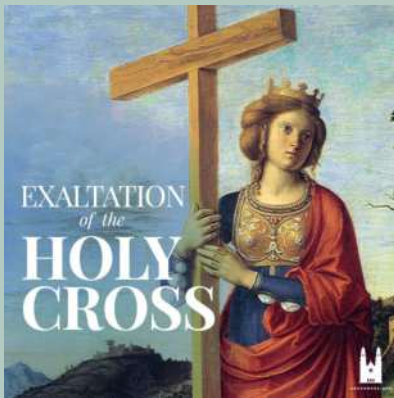
FAMILY FAITH FORMATION THIS SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 14

THE STORY OF THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS



Early in the fourth century, Saint Helena, mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine, went to Jerusalem in search of the holy places of Christ's life. She razed the second-century Temple of Aphrodite, which tradition held was built over the Savior's tomb, and her son built the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher on that spot. During the excavation, workers found three crosses. Legend has it that the one on which Jesus died was identified when its touch healed a dying woman.

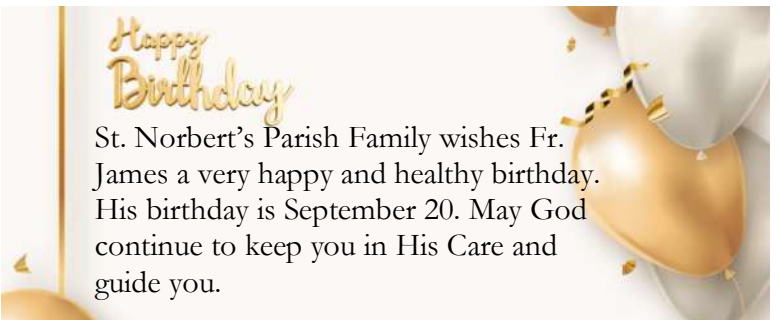
