Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord
March 24, 2024

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we approach the holiest week of the year, Holy Week, I want to extend a warm invitation to all of you to join our parish community in prayer and reflection. This sacred time offers a powerful opportunity to deepen our faith and reconnect with the transformative story of Jesus' sacrifice and glorious resurrection.

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday, on March 24th this year. We will begin the liturgy with the blessing of palms, recalling the joyous entry of Jesus into Jerusalem. This day marks the start of the most significant events in our faith.

Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of Holy Week offer a chance for quiet contemplation. We will have daily Masses focusing on specific moments leading up to the Last Supper. These Masses allow us to ponder the depth of Jesus' love and the weight of the burdens he carried.

On Holy Thursday, we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper. This evening liturgy commemorates the Last Supper, where Jesus instituted the Holy Eucharist – the very foundation of our Church. Following the Mass, we will have a special prayer vigil, allowing us to accompany Jesus in spirit through the night of his betrayal.

Good Friday is a solemn day of fasting and abstinence. We gather for the Celebration of the Lord's Passion, where we remember Jesus' suffering and crucifixion. The veneration of the cross becomes a central focus, reminding us of the immense price paid for our salvation.

The holiest night of the year, the Easter Vigil, takes place on Holy Saturday. This beautiful nighttime liturgy marks the culmination of Holy Week and the anticipation of Christ's resurrection. Through readings, blessings, and the renewal of baptismal vows, we participate in the profound mystery of new life emerging from death.

The culmination of our journey arrives on Easter Sunday, the joyous celebration of Christ's victory over death. We rejoice in the power of God's love and the promise of eternal life.

I encourage you to participate in as many liturgies as you are able during Holy Week. Each one offers a unique perspective on the unfolding drama of salvation. Let us walk this sacred path together, reflecting on Jesus' sacrifice and ultimately celebrating the glorious hope of the Resurrection.

PASSIONTIDE

Passiontide begins on the fifth Sunday of Lent. During Passiontide, statues and crosses are covered with purple or red cloths. This practice has roots in 9th



century Germany. At the beginning of Lent, a cloth called a Hungertuch, or Hunger Cloth, covered the altar. During the Middle Ages, statues of saints and other images were covered at the start of Lent. Beginning in the 17th century, veiling was limited to Passiontide instead of throughout Lent.

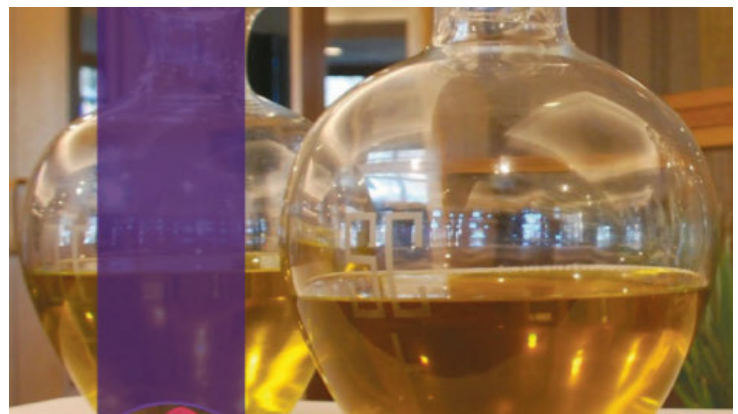
