This Monday, June 6, we celebrate the Feast day of St. Norbert, as well as the amazing 176th Anniversary of the founding of our parish! My warmest gratitude goes to all the families who have loved and supported the church over the years. Aside from our normal morning Masses, on June 6th Fr. Matthew Pearson, the newly ordained priest of our Diocese, will be offering an evening Mass in honor of the Saint at beautiful St. Norbert. Fr. The readings will also be in English. At the end of Mass, he will be offering his 1st Priestly Blessings (i.e. a chance to earn a plenary indulgence) to all who wish to come forward.
