Dear Parishioners,

As we raise our branches this coming Palm Sunday, we cross the threshold into the most sacred time of our church year: Holy Week. This is not merely a time to remember historical events from two thousand years ago; it is a profound invitation to actively walk alongside Jesus through His passion, death, and glorious resurrection.

While the demands of our daily lives do not pause, Holy Week calls us to intentionally set aside time to immerse ourselves in the great mystery of our faith. I warmly encourage you and your family to join our pastorate family for the liturgies of the Sacred Triduum, the three days that form the summit of our liturgical year.

Experiencing the fullness of Easter joy is deeply magnified when we have first walked the path of the upper room, the garden, and the cross together.

Though taking place over three days, the Triduum is actually considered one continuous liturgy that unfolds step by step.

Holy Thursday: The Mass of the Lord's Supper We remember the institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood. Through the washing of the feet, we are reminded of Christ's ultimate mandate: to love and serve one another. The evening concludes not with a dismissal, but in quiet adoration, keeping watch with Christ.

Good Friday: The Passion of the Lord On the only day of the year when Mass is not celebrated, we gather in solemn remembrance of Christ's sacrifice. We listen to the Passion narrative, pray the Solemn Intercessions for the needs of the world, and step forward to venerate the wood of the Cross.

Holy Saturday: The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night The mother of all vigils! We begin in darkness, light the new Paschal fire, and listen to the story of our salvation history. We welcome new members into our faith through Baptism and Confirmation, and the "Alleluia" returns as we celebrate the first Mass of the Resurrection.

If you have never attended the Triduum liturgies, or if it has been a few years, make this the year you attend. Bring your burdens, your joys, and your family to the foot of the altar. Let us journey together through the darkness of Friday into the brilliant light of Easter morning.

Plan Your Holy Week & Confessions: Because our pastorate spans three beautiful parishes, our Holy Week liturgies and expanded Confession times are shared across our different church locations.

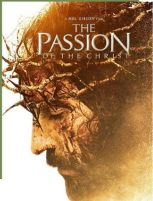

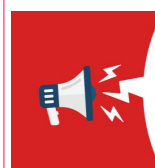
