Cemetery Committee Meeting Minutes
March 30, 2022

Attendees: Father James, Marvin and Harriett Breunig, Juanita Wipperfurth, Paul Merline, Derrick Ballweg, Chris Goodwin

1. Opening Prayer

2. Read and approve the minutes from the February 27, 2020, meeting. Meeting minutes were read and approved.

3. Financial Report – Financial report was distributed to all in attendance, explanation was made to Father James and Chris Goodwin regarding the Diocese of Madison’s requirement to maintain a separate endowment fund for perpetual care. Income and expenses were discussed, nothing out of the ordinary occurred. Paul will contact Dryden concerning questions about some debits and credits on the Stifel statement.

4. Old Business

- A. Cleaning of area for extension of cemetery - Knights of Columbus. The Knights of Columbus did a great job with the cleanup and Paul will be thanking them again for their efforts.
- B. Number of plots left in the current cemetery: singles, doubles - Currently, there are five double plots and eight single plots in the original cemetery. Paul asked for clarification of number of cremations allowed per plot, at this time, three cremations are allowed per plot. Juanita will contact Diocese of Madison to see what number they allow.
- C. Power washing monument: Spellman was scheduled to complete Spring of 2020. Spellman had stated that someone would be coming to power wash the monuments, however no one has ever showed up. Marvin will contact Spellman again to see if they are planning to do it this year.
- D. CD from Anchor (Old National Bank) was transferred to BMO Harris Bank, Sauk City
- E. New Driveway: Follow up (D.L. Gasser) D.L. Gasser paved the new driveway during the spring of 2021
- F. New Easements printed (Giegerich’s Sons, Prairie du Sac) Easements were updated and printed
- G. Mark Ruhland did the mowing in 2020 and 2021. Mark has done a great job with mowing
- H. Approval to pay gratuity to Marvin and Juanita – previously approved

5. New Business

- A. Switching banks from BMO Harris, Sauk City to Bank of Prairie du Sac. Harriett is working with Finance Council President, Ed Breunig, to move the cemetery accounts. Maturing CD’s will be transferred after the maturity dates are reached
- B. Mark Ruhland – Mark Ruhland has agreed to mow the cemetery grounds in 2022. Recommendation was made to increase the hourly rate for Mark. Committee will check with the Finance Council to see what his current rate is.
- C. Build up dirt around the new driveway - (Collin Breunig) Collin Breunig, CB Silt Fence, Erosion Control and Excavating, provided a quote to place and grade new screened topsoil around the driveway edge as well as seed and mulch. Derrick will contact Collin to proceed with the work.
- D. New mower needed – The existing mower is several years old and requires maintenance repairs yearly to keep it operational. Harriett is obtaining quotes for a commercial mower due to the significant hours needed to maintain the cemetery lawn each year. A few other recommendations were made for obtaining quotes and Harriett will pursue. Harriett will summarize the quotes and a decision will be made by the committee either via phone or email.

E. Cremation fees/plot fees. The Diocese of Madison suggested that any cemetery that had not had a fee increase in the last few years consider raising their rates. After reviewing the cemetery rates from Sauk City, Lodi, and Baraboo, the committee voted on raising the fees. Fees will be increased on July 1, 2022, to the following:

\$550.00/plot or \$1100.00/two plots. Cremations will be \$250.00 if placed upon an existing plot. Perpetual Care fee will remain the same.

Marvin informed the committee that he no longer does any digging in the cemetery for cremations, Tom Lindley handles all of it. Due to that reason the excavation fee listed on the cemetery price list will be discontinued.

F. Status of Allianz payment – Father James and Juanita are currently filling out the required paperwork to receive the life insurance payment which was originally obtained by Father Meier for the cemetery.

6. Other comments Marvin is trying to remove a tree that has regrown and is intertwined within the arborvitaes. Chris Goodwin will look for a herbicide that will prevent regrowth and not damage the arborvitaes.

7. Next meeting date - March 29, 2023
