For young families, this is a key moment to prepare for the year ahead — and to make decisions that will shape your children's future.

This is the perfect time to highlight the gift and mission of Catholic education. I strongly encourage all families with young children to consider enrolling them at St. Aloysius School, serving PreK through 8th grade. This year marks our first year as a full Middle School (6th–8th grades) — an exciting milestone in our pastorate's commitment to forming the next generation.

If you have never accessed your profile before, simply click *Request Account* on the login page, select your parish from the list, and enter your name, email, and phone number. Once your access is set up, you'll be able to register your children online.

And while you're marking your calendar, don't forget that our Parish Festival is right around the corner! This is one of the highlights of our year — a joyful way to wrap up the summer with great food, games, music, and fellowship. We are still in need of sponsors, especially to help cover the cost of children's games. We are also looking for volunteers to help bring the day to life. Sponsorships, donations, and a helping hand go a long way toward making the festival a success.

Let's make these last weeks of summer count — preparing our children for a strong school year, deepening our pastorate community, and celebrating together before the school bell rings again.

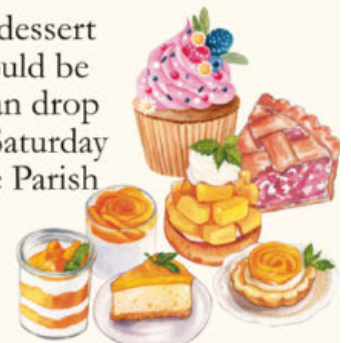

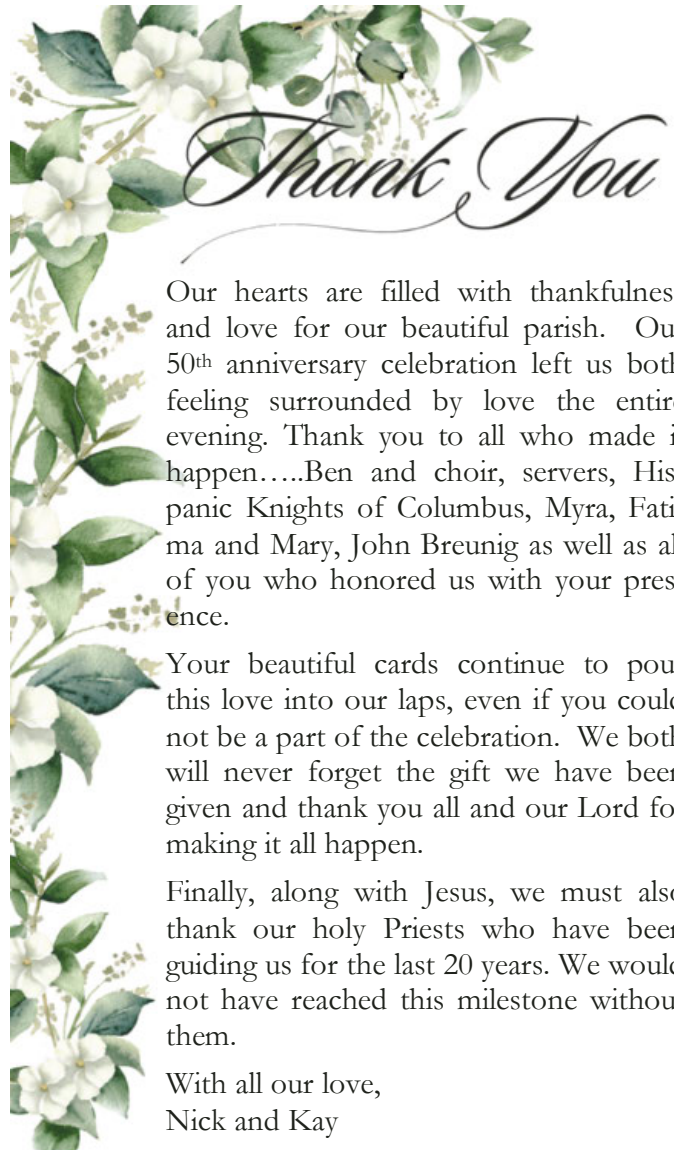

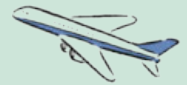

### ADORATION VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

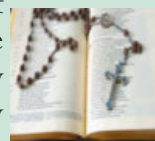
