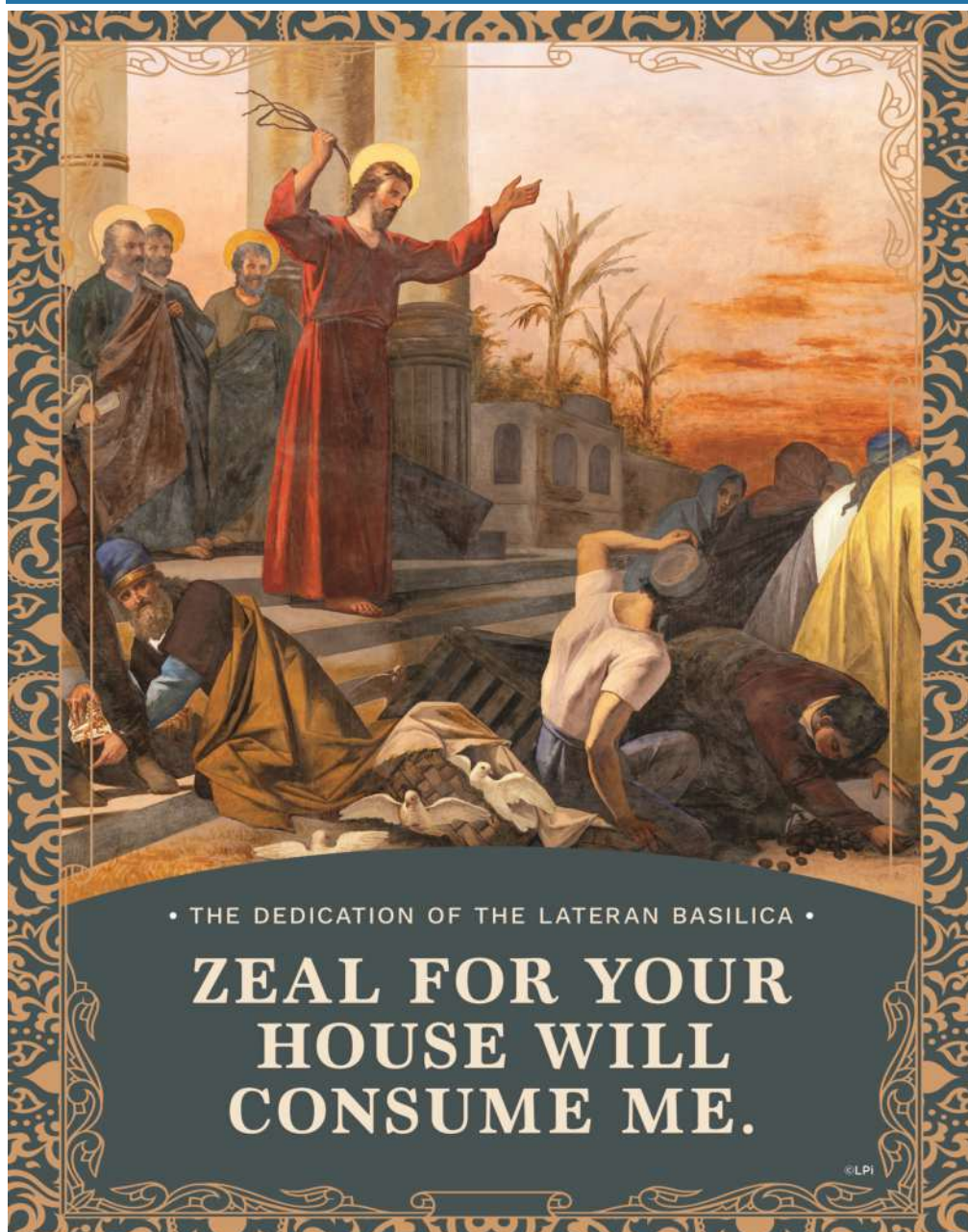

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Dear Parishioners,

The month of November is a special time in our Church's calendar. It is a time when we prayerfully remember the souls of the faithful departed, especially during this "Month of All Souls." This focus on the faithful departed naturally leads us to reflect on our own journey and the reality of death—not with fear, but with the profound hope we have in Jesus Christ.



To help us all prepare for this reality, I am pleased to announce that our parish will be offering a new four-part video study

called **Eternal Rest: The Art of Dying Well**.

This beautiful series from the Augustine Institute helps us understand the Church's compassionate teachings on death, the afterlife, and our belief in the resurrection. It is not a morbid or frightening series; rather, it's a hope-filled one. It reminds us that "Christ turns the grave from a hole into a door. Death is no longer a pit, but a door into eternal life".

Over four weeks, we will explore:

- ◆ The Story of Death: Where death came from and how God conquered it.
- ◆ The Afterlife: The reality of heaven, hell, and purgatory.
- ◆ The Hour of Our Death: The power and grace of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.
- ◆ The Faithful Departed: How we care for the souls of the deceased and navigate grief with Christian hope.

This study is a wonderful opportunity to grow in faith, comfort those who grieve, and prepare our own hearts for the day we are called home to the Lord.

I invite all of you to join us.
