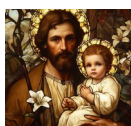

# A VISIT FROM VICTOR E. AND FRIENDS



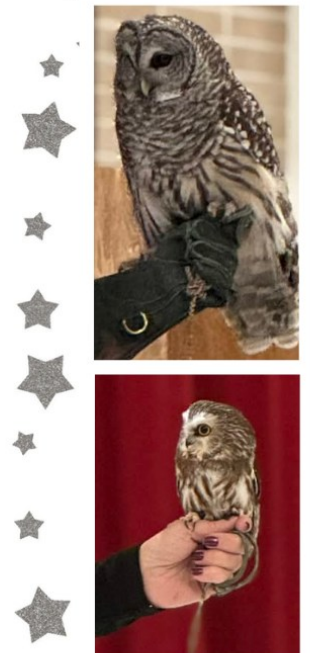

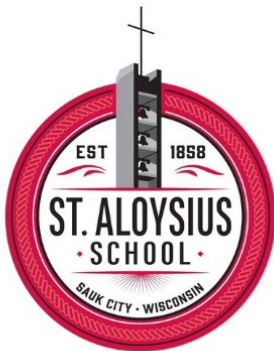
