2nd Sunday of Lent February 25, 2024 Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we enter the season of Lent, we are called to repentance and conversion of heart. One of the most powerful ways to experience God's mercy and forgiveness is through the sacrament of Confession, also known as Reconciliation or Penance.

Confession is not only a means of obtaining pardon for our sins, but also a source of grace and strength to overcome them. It helps us to grow in holiness and intimacy with God, who loves us unconditionally and desires our salvation.

The Church encourages us to receive this sacrament regularly, especially during Lent, as a preparation for Easter. To help you make a good confession, here are some tips:

- Examine your conscience before going to confession. You can use the Ten Commandments, the Beatitudes, or other guides to help you identify your sins and faults.
- Be sincere and honest with yourself and with God. Do not hide or justify your sins, but admit them humbly and contritely.
- Confess your sins to the priest, who represents Christ and the Church. Tell him the kind and number of your sins, and any circumstances that may affect their gravity.
- Listen to the priest's advice and counsel. He will give you a penance to perform, which may be a prayer, an act of charity, or a sacrifice.
- Express your sorrow for your sins and your resolution to avoid them in the future. You can use an act of contrition or your own words.
- Receive absolution from the priest, who will say the words of forgiveness in the name of God and the Church.
- Thank God for his mercy and grace. Do your penance as soon as possible, and try to amend your life with the help of his grace.

To facilitate your access to this sacrament, we have updated our schedule of confessions on our pastorate website. You can also find resources online to help you prepare for confession.

We are happy to announce that Fr. Faustino is back

from his annual retreat, and that we will be able to hear confessions at all the weekend Masses at St. Aloysius. On Wednesday of Holy Week, we will have a special Penance Service from 4:30 PM to 7:30 PM at St. Aloysius Church. Four priests will be hearing confessions, and we will also have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at the church.

We invite you to take advantage of this opportunity to receive God's mercy and healing. Let us approach the throne of grace with confidence and joy, knowing that God is always ready to forgive us and welcome us back to his love.

May God bless you and your families during this Lenten season.
