Dear Parishioners,

Recent events have brought to my attention the need for a gentle reminder about the proper way to receive Holy Communion. An instance was observed where a person, after receiving the consecrated Host, did not consume it immediately but rather put it away. This provides us with an opportunity to reflect on the profound mystery we participate in at every Mass and to ensure we all approach Our Lord in the Eucharist with the utmost reverence and love.

It is important to remember that the Holy Eucharist is not a mere symbol or a piece of bread. The Host we receive is, in the truest and most substantial sense, the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ. Through the words of consecration spoken by the priest, an extraordinary miracle takes place. This is the Real Presence of Christ. When we approach the altar for Holy Communion, we are approaching Christ Himself. This is the heart of our Catholic faith and the source and summit of our Christian life.

As the minister of this sacred sacrament, the priest has a solemn obligation to ensure that Our Lord is treated with the respect and reverence He is due. This duty extends to safeguarding the consecrated Hosts from any potential irreverence or profanation. Part of this sacred trust is ensuring that each person who receives Holy Communion consumes the Host in their presence.

When you come forward to receive Holy Communion, a bow of the head is the proper gesture of reverence before receiving the sacrament. The minister will hold up the Host and say, "The Body of Christ," to which you should respond with a clear and heartfelt "Amen." This "Amen" is your statement of faith in the Real Presence.

Crucially, the Host must be consumed immediately in front of the priest or minister. Under no circumstances should a person walk away with the Host without consuming it. To do so can be a cause for scandal and, in the most serious cases, can lead to the desecration of the Blessed Sacrament. If you are unable to consume the Host for any reason, you should immediately inform the priest.

While the Church permits the reception of Holy Communion in the hand, the traditional practice of receiving on the tongue is the preferred method in our churches. This practice is rich in theological meaning and is a beautiful way to show our love, humility, and homage to our Eucharistic King.

Receiving on the tongue signifies our recognition that

we are like children being fed by our Heavenly Father. It is an act of total surrender and trust, acknowledging that we are receiving a gift that we are not worthy to take into our own hands. By allowing the priest, who acts *in persona Christi*, to place the Host on our tongue, we emphasize the sacredness of the sacrament and protect it from any accidental profanation.

Furthermore, when possible, kneeling to receive Holy Communion is a powerful expression of adoration. Bending the knee before our Creator and Redeemer present in the Eucharist is a profound exterior sign of our interior disposition of worship and awe. It is a humble recognition of His majesty and our dependence on Him.

Let us all take this opportunity to deepen our love and appreciation for the incredible gift of the Holy Eucharist. By receiving Our Lord with proper reverence and devotion, we not only give Him the honor He is due but also open our hearts more fully to the abundant graces He desires to pour out upon us.
