This Fourth of July weekend, as we gather with family and friends for barbecues and fireworks, it is fitting to reflect on the blessings of our nation and the true meaning of the freedoms we celebrate. While Independence Day is a civic holiday, for us as Catholics, the love for our country—patriotism—is a virtue with deep roots in our faith.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that patriotism flows from the commandment to honor our father and mother. This duty of gratitude extends to the land that has nurtured us, the communities that have shaped us, and the nation that has provided for our security and liberty. If patriotism is a sincere and grateful love for our country, then it should naturally lead us to thank God for the many gifts and blessings He has bestowed upon the United States. 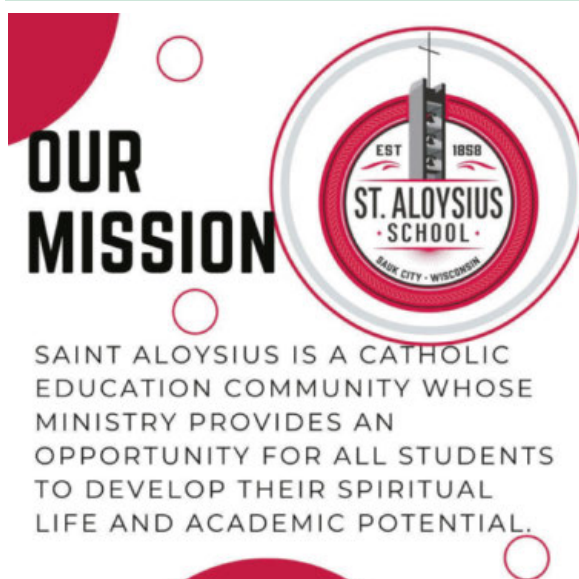

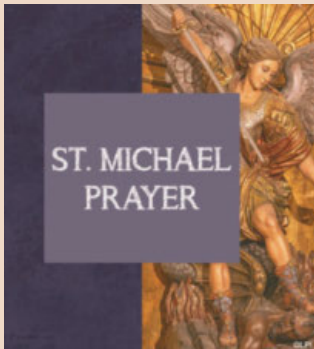
### FAMILY FAITH FORMATION THIS SUNDAY, JULY 6TH
