A HEALING PRESENCE IN OUR PARISHES

The Diocese of Madison has partnered with the Association of Catholic Mental Health Ministers <https://catholicmhm.org> in responding to Bishop Donald Hying's call to develop stronger parish-based mental health ministry and resources throughout the Diocese of Madison.

We are all being offered a free opportunity which will assist those suffering from mental illness and also educate and increase our awareness of their suffering. The Sanctuary Course for Catholics will be presented as a Zoom online course beginning on **May 9 at 6:00pm** and is being offered to the entire diocese. This eight-session course on consecutive Monday nights is designed to raise awareness and start conversations in local parishes regarding mental health and requires no previous training or expertise. The sessions are accompanied by compelling films that feature the stories of Catholics living with mental health challenges, along with the insights of archbishops, theologians and psychologists.
