GO MAKE DISCIPLES TIP OF THE MONTH

As we go into the last month of summer, it can feel a little overwhelming at times with all that is going on. We've been busy with sports like baseball and softball. The summer holidays are filled with parades, BBQ's and pool parties with family and friends. There are fairs, festivals and vacations, oh my! With all that is filling our calendars it can be easy to lose sight of our relationship with God and unintentionally put him on the back burner because we are "busy". Here are a few ideas to think about to prioritize God in your summer plans.

1. Make sure to still attend Mass weekly, either on Saturday or Sunday. Think about your weekend a day or so in advance. What games or events do you have scheduled, and which Mass does that mean your family will attend? If traveling out of town for the weekend, it's so easy to Google a Catholic church near where you'll be vacationing. Bonus points if you invite someone, you're spending that weekend with to Mass with you.
2. Find some quiet time for prayer and reflection. What are you thankful for? What do you need God's help with? Is there someone else in your life that you need to pray for? Consider stopping in for Adoration on a Thursday, or any other day, to help slow down and spend one-on-one uninterrupted time with God.
3. Find little pockets of time to include God in your daily activity. Maybe that's listening to a podcast or radio station like Life 102.5 when you're doing housework or driving to that campsite.
4. Soak up these sunshine-filled days during the month of August; don't forget to slow down and express gratitude for all the beauty God provides us.
