We are thrilled to announce that we are in the process of bringing a beautiful and transformative faith formation program called Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) to the Mary, Mother of Mercy Pastorate.

What is Catechesis of the Good Shepherd?

CGS is a catechesis program designed for children ages 3 to 12. It is a deeply peaceful, beautiful program that engages children in hands-on work rooted in sacred scripture and the Liturgy of the Mass. Rather than traditional classroom learning, children learn about their faith by working with beautiful, tactile materials that help them contemplate God and build a relationship with Jesus, the Good Shepherd.

Next year, we are planning to open our first level for children ages 3 to 6. As our program grows, we hope to add the subsequent levels for our older children in the coming years.

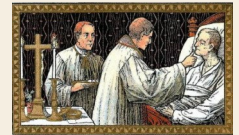

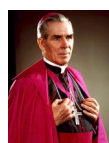

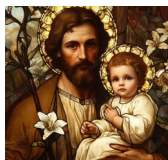
