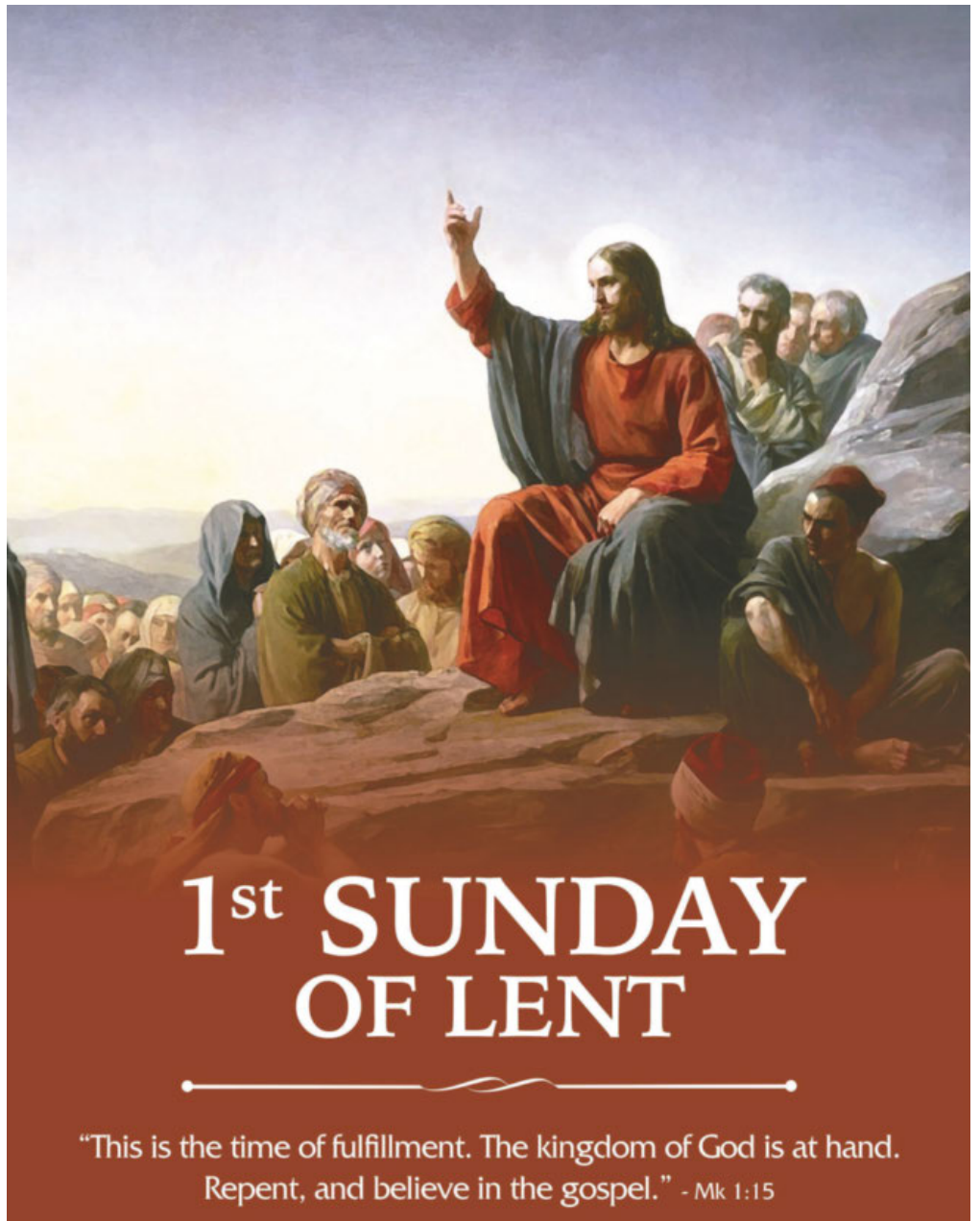

1st Sunday of Lent
February 18, 2024

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we begin our Lenten journey, a time of reflection, repentance, and renewal, I invite you to join me in the 1% Lenten Challenge. This simple yet powerful practice calls for us to intentionally dedicate just 1% of our day to prayer and conversation with God.

Why is this important? Just as a house without a solid foundation will crumble, our spiritual lives, without the bedrock of prayer, will struggle to withstand the storms of daily life. Jesus Himself repeatedly sought solitude and prayer to strengthen His relationship with the Father.

Throughout Lent, let us follow His example by carving out even 15 minutes per day – that's just 1% – for uninterrupted dialogue with the Lord. Perhaps it's early in the morning before the day's activities begin, during a lunch break, or in the quiet of the evening as you wind down.

How to get started:

- Choose a dedicated time and place. Consistency helps establish a rhythm of prayer.
- Engage with Scripture. Whether through the daily Mass readings, devotional guides, or Lectio Divina (meditative reading), let God's Word speak to you.
- Talk to God as a friend. Offer your burdens, gratitude, and intercessions for loved ones and the world.
- Rest in silence. Don't be afraid to allow space for God's quiet whispers to your heart.

This 1% Challenge during Lent is a small investment with profound potential. As we nurture our prayer lives, we become more receptive to God's grace, more attuned to His will, and more courageous in sharing His love with those around us.

To help you take the 1% Lenten Challenge, we have prepared some resources for you. In the church lobbies, you will find a 1% Challenge card that contains instructions for praying with Scripture, using the ancient method of Lectio Divina (divine reading). The card also has 47 Scripture verses that you can use for your daily prayer, one for each day of Lent and Holy Week.

Let's make this Lent a season of deeper spiritual connection. Remember, every time you dedicate even a few minutes to prayer, you are strengthening the foundation of your faith and growing closer to the heart of Christ.

May God bless your Lenten journey!

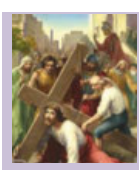

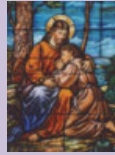

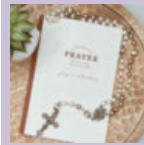
