GO MAKE DISCIPLES TIP OF THE MONTH

Go Make Disciples would like to focus on the Pillar of Sunday Mass this Month. Sunday Mass is the center of our Catholic faith and practice, as we gather to worship God, hear the Word, share in the death and rising of the Lord and receive the most Holy Eucharist. Additionally, Sundays should be days free of servile work, dedicated to worship, prayer, time spent with family and friends, rest, study and works of charity. In this way, we honor the meaning of Sabbath and the primacy of our relationship with God. A few ideas for your family on Sundays:

WORSHIP: The Mass is the sacrifice of Christ on the cross literally made present on our altars. It is the greatest of human acts. We should act like it by arriving on time or even a little early; by trying to enter deeply into the Mass through the offering our own hearts on the altar of sacrifice; and by receiving the Body of our Lord with great reverence and devotion.

FOOD: eat a meal together as a family or with Friends

FAMILY/FRIENDS: do something active together

FUN: enjoy cultural experiences (sports, concerts, farmer's markets)

SERVICE: do works of mercy

PRAYER: return to prayer in the afternoon or evening (Sunday Vespers; Family Rosary; cemetery visit).
