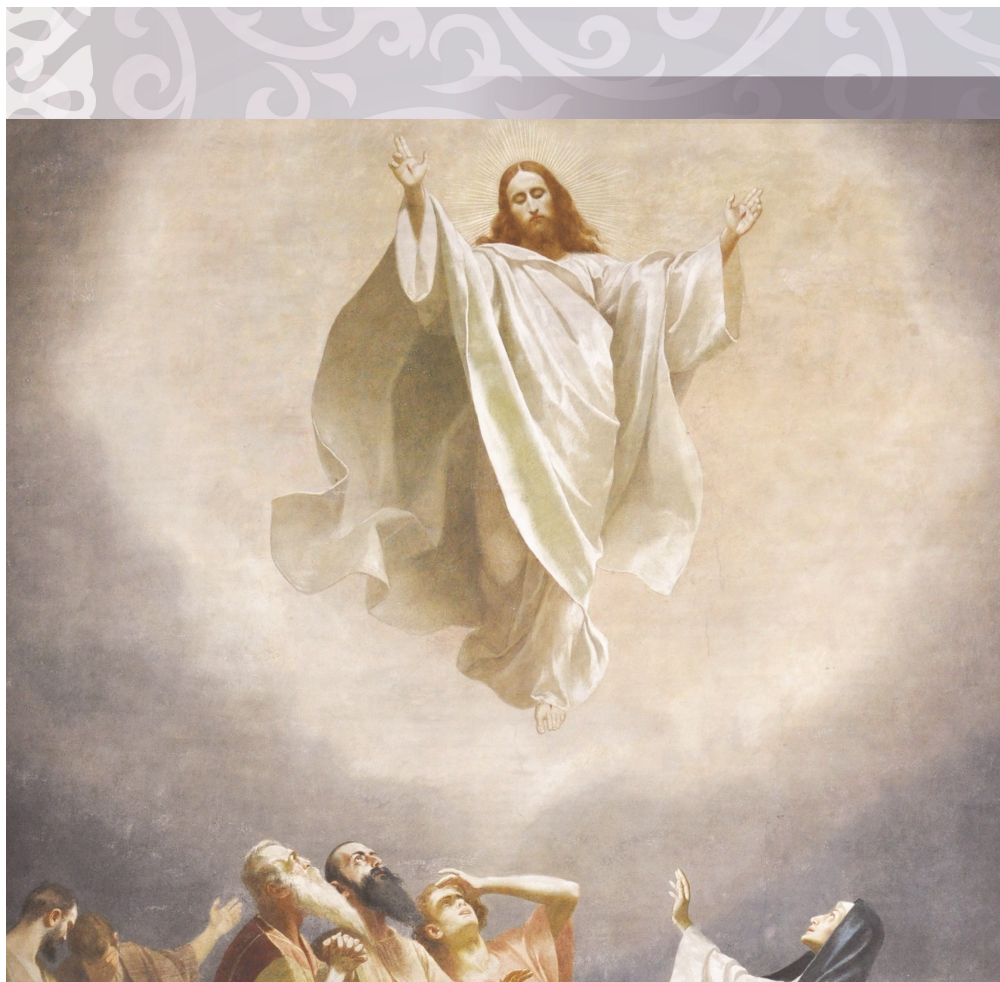

Dear Parishioners,

Earlier this week I sent a Flocknote to the pastorate sharing news of several staffing changes at St. Aloysius School and within our parish offices as we prepare for the next academic year. Finally, a word of congratulations and prayer: this Tuesday, our confirmandi will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. To each of you about to be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit — we are so proud of you, and we will be praying for you as you take this important step in your life of faith. To your catechists, who have walked with you through preparation: thank you for the time, care, and witness you have given. To your parents, who first handed on the faith to you: thank you for bringing your children to this moment. And to your sponsors, who have stood beside you in friendship and prayer: thank you for saying yes to this responsibility. May the Holy Spirit fill all of you with His gifts.
