Julianne read the minutes from the Thursday, November 18, 2021 meeting. Minutes were approved as read.

**Finance Update**

February 1, 2022 Finance Council Meeting minutes shared.

Capital Campaign:

Stained Glass Windows:

Contractor now believes that the whole project can be completed this year. Chris to reach out on the construction process, timeline, and intrusiveness. **Buildings and Grounds:**

Boiler replacement completed. We were very pleased with the process and quality of the work.

Water leak in Rectory basement has been repaired. It was due to a rusted pipe.

Custodian Tim Knobloch is doing well with his shoulder and will continue to monitor.

Thank you to Del Endres and Chris Schmitt who replaced the lights in the Church and cleaned the ceiling fans.

An additional 11 or 12 trees were removed. Thank you to Chris Goodwin, Jerome Ballweg, Steve Schoepp, and Dusty Ziegler for their work and assistance with this project.

The Rectory gutter was damaged in December and the repair has been completed and insurance claim approved.

We completed our Catholic Mutual Self Inspection Report and overall, we had a very good report. Actions needed were posted emergency plans in the RE Center and adding 9"-12" of cushioned material under the playground. Brian Breunig to review and provide quote on the bark.

Sound system in the choir loft was reviewed with John Breunig. Thank you to John for his help in connecting the speakers in the loft and helping with microphones.

There was a water issue in the back basement storage room. It was cleaned up and aired out.

Confessional doorknob was fixed.

MG&E replaced caps and are going to fix the blacktop at the corner between the basement and garage.
