## MASKS REQUIRED

Public Health Madison & Dane County issued [Face Covering Emergency Order #7](#). The Dane County Order requires face coverings among people ages two and older when in most enclosed spaces open to the public where other people are present. The order will expire on **March 1, 2022**.

The Order requires face coverings among people ages two and older when in most enclosed spaces open to the public where other people are present. Wearing multi-layered, [well-fitting masks](#) is especially important due to the easily transmissible Omicron variant. The order does include an exception if all individuals in an enclosed space are fully-vaccinated.

**There are no diocesan guidelines at this time except to follow any county civil orders, where applicable, and to follow CDC guidelines.**

Everyone is asked to get their orders in as soon as possible. Information is in the bulletin, will be sent home with the Religious Education Students, and is on the Facebook page.

After a discussion about the possibility of hosting a BINGO night it was decided to table that idea for now. The officers have learned that there is a lot more involved than anyone was aware. A special license would have been needed along with the purchase of authorized cards.
