MENTAL HELATH MINISTRY STARTING

Divine Mercy Parish has made a commitment to become a parish that both understands mental illness and can provide compassionate support. We recognize that mental illness can affect many people and is not the result of personal weakness or a lack of character.

As a parish, we can make a difference in people's lives by offering spiritual support through our prayerful presence in people's lives and our understanding of what people are experiencing.

Divine Mercy Parish will kick off their mental health ministry with a 5 week session beginning on Tuesday, September 13, 6:30pm – 8:00pm and continuing for the next 5 weeks. Please come when you can or view the online recording of group speakers offered on the parish website. We offer these nights to people suffering from mental illness, their families, or those who wish to learn more about this ongoing suffering in our community.

Each night offers a speaker on various topics, including a mental health professional. The last night, October 11, we will offer a resource fair with tables set up offering local resources and personnel. Decisions will then be made about offering an ongoing support group in our parish.

Our parish mental health ministry is not intended to replace professional services. We are trained in appropriate procedures to maintain the privacy of those with whom we relate. LIFELINE SCREENING

Why Get Screened?

Taking preventive steps such as making lifestyle changes and getting health screenings may help you avoid a stroke or other serious health events in the future. Early intervention is important. If you are over fifty and have diabetes, high cholesterol, high blood pressure or if you have a family history of stroke or heart disease, you may be at risk, even if you feel great. In fact, four out of five people who suffer a stroke have no apparent symptoms and nearly 30% of strokes occur under the age of 65. The good news is that according to the National Stroke Association, 80% of strokes can be prevented. Life Line Screening will help you find out if you are at risk, so you and your doctor can take the next steps and be proactive about your health.
