Dear Parishioners,

Just a general announcement: As you may know, there is currently an 8am Traditional Latin Mass on Saturday mornings at St. Barnabas in Mazomanie. After speaking with Fr. Osvaldo, we have decided to move that Mass from St. Barnabas to St. Norbert beginning January 28. **All those wishing to attend the Traditional Latin Mass on Saturday mornings, please be advised that starting Saturday, January 28, there will no longer be Mass or confessions at St. Barnabas on Saturday mornings, but you will still be able to come for the TLM at 8am at St. Norbert, with confessions starting at 7:15am.** We are in the process of transferring Mass intentions from St. Barnabas to our secretary (Juanita Wipperfurth) in Roxbury, but in the meantime you may still contact Fr. Osvaldo to check up on intentions. **Please know, however, that starting January 28, all TLM intentions for Saturday morning will be said at St. Norbert and not at St. Barnabas.** Please feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns. Please also note that this does not change our normal Mass schedule (for TLM and English Masses) at St. Norbert in any way.

GO MAKE DISCIPLES TIP OF THE MONTH

The January tip from your GMD group is about starting 2023 as a stronger Catholic and setting some faith forward resolutions for you and your family. The month of January is dedicated to the Holy Name of Jesus, which is celebrated on Jan 3rd. The first ten days of January fall during the liturgical season known as Christmas which is represented by the liturgical color white, and the color of light, a symbol of joy, purity and innocence (absolute or restored). The remaining days of January are the beginning of Ordinary Time, which is represented by the liturgical color green. This symbol of hope is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection. This year set your goals for the 4 Pillars of Go Make Disciples: 15 minutes of daily prayer- Reclaiming Sunday- Monthly Confession-Friday Penance. Sit down and write down your goals for the year on how to bring these Pillars to the forefront of your faith for a great year ahead.
