## FAST AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholic. For members of the Catholic Church, the norms for fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that are not equal to a full meal.

In addition, Fridays, during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding for members of the Catholic Church from the age of 14 onward.

## MASKS REQUIRED

Public Health Madison & Dane County issued [Face Covering Emergency Order #7](#). The Dane County Order requires face coverings among people ages two and older when in most enclosed spaces open to the public where other people are present. The order will expire on **March 1, 2022**.

The Order requires face coverings among people ages two and older when in most enclosed spaces open to the public where other people are present. Wearing multi-layered, [well-fitting masks](#) is especially important due to the easily transmissible Omicron variant. The order does include an exception if all individuals in an enclosed space are fully-vaccinated.

**There are no diocesan guidelines at this time except to follow any county civil orders, where applicable, and to follow CDC guidelines.**
