ST. BLAISE

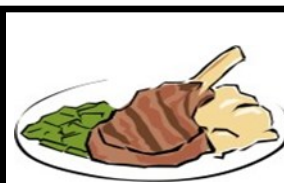
February 3 was the Feast of St. Blaise. Fr. James will offer the St. Blaise after ALL weekend Masses, February 4 and 5.
