Dear Parishioners,

On June 9, I will be departing for Spain for my annual retreat and some time of prayer and renewal. God willing, I will return on July 10.

As in previous years, there is no need to worry. The sacramental and pastoral needs of our parish communities will continue to be well cared for. We are blessed to have several priests available to assist with Masses, confessions, anointing of the sick, and other pastoral needs during my absence.

I am also happy to share that Fr. Jerry Zhanay will be joining us while I am away. Many of you will remember Fr. Jerry from his years serving the faithful of St. Norbert in Roxbury. We are grateful for his willingness to return and help care for our pastorate during this time. Please give him a warm welcome when you see him.

I would also like to remind everyone of an important event taking place next week. On June 11, the bishops of the United States will consecrate our nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This historic act is being carried out as our country prepares to celebrate the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence.

Why is this important?

A consecration is an act of trust. It is a public acknowledgment that Jesus Christ is Lord and that we desire our lives, our families, and our nation to be guided by His love and His truth. By consecrating our country to the Sacred Heart, the bishops are entrusting our nation to the mercy, protection, and kingship of Christ.

We live in a time marked by division, confusion, loneliness, and a growing forgetfulness of God. The Sacred Heart reminds us that the answer to our deepest problems is not merely political or economic, but spiritual. Our nation needs conversion. We need hearts transformed by the love of Christ.

The bishops have also explained that this consecration is an act of reparation for the sins and failures of our nation, while at the same time calling us to greater charity toward the poor, the suffering, and those who are far from God. It is a reminder that devotion to the Sacred Heart is not simply a private devotion but a call to



live the Gospel more fully.

If you have not already done so, I encourage you to participate in the novena to the Sacred Heart that has been distributed through Flocknote and to spend some time before the Blessed Sacrament praying for our country. Let us ask the Sacred Heart of Jesus to heal our divisions, strengthen our families, renew our faith, and draw our nation closer to Him.

Please keep me in your prayers during my retreat, and know that I will be remembering all of you in mine.

NOVENA PRAYER TO ST. ALOYSIUS

Starting on Saturday, June 13th, everyday after Mass (weekday Masses will be after 8:15am) we will pray a Novena prayer to St. Aloysius, our Patron Saint.

St. Aloysius Gonzaga was an Italian saint who lived in the 1500s. St. Aloysius was the eldest of seven children born to Ferrante Gonzaga, marchese di Castiglione. Destined for a military career as a nobleman, he was educated at the ducal courts of Florence and Mantua and at the royal court of Madrid, where he was page to King Philip II's son Diego. He was a member of the Jesuit order. St. Aloysius Gonzaga was known for his purity and charity. He died while caring for those suffering from an epidemic. You can use this novena to seek intercession from this holy boy in your life!



WHY PRAY THE ST. ALOYSIUS GONZAGA'S NOVENA?

St. Aloysius Gonzaga is the patron saint of young students and of Christian youth. You can ask him to pray for any young students or Christian youth you might know who are in need of prayers. 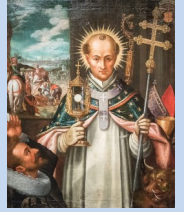
