## STAINED GLASS WINDOW REPAIR UPDATE

We've had many questions concerning exactly what was done to each of the stained glass windows. We received the following description from Jimmy, the head of the project: "Window Restoration Process The first thing that was done was to remove the old protective covering and then scrape all loose paint/debris from the windows. All bulging was fixed. The next step was recementing the stained glass windows which is a process that involves mixing and blending window glazing, mineral spirits, and color together. The window glazing repacks the glass and lead to stiffen the windows. The mineral spirits clean all the glass. The blended color redyes the lead and cement. Next was taping and caulking any cracks in window framing as well as replacing window framing that was beyond repair. The window framing was then painted with two coats of Sherwin Williams paint. The next step was to install the perimeter framing that holds the protective acrylic covering in place. The acrylic is then sealed to the frame and the frame to the stone with Silproof which is a very strong sealant. This process was repeated for each window." Note that this is an abbreviated version of the process as there was a lot of detail and hard work involved in the project.
