Dear Parishioners,

Mark your calendars! Our annual Pastorate Festival is just around the corner, and this year we want to place a special emphasis on celebrating the beautiful reality that is our pastorate family.

It is a great hope that everyone can see and feel that our pastorate is truly like a family. We are blessed to have a cohesive group of priests who live and work together, alongside the consecrated women of the Society of Jesus Christ the Priest (SJCP). We have all known each other for a long time, and this common life, rooted in a shared spirituality and ministry style, gives our work a certain “familiarity.” In these changing times, we hope this provides comfort and stability for you, our parishioners. In December of 2026, we will mark 20 years of service here, a testament to the stable, family-like bond we have built together.

Over these many years, we have had the privilege of getting to know so many of you. This was profoundly felt this past spring during the preparation for Confirmation. It was a moment of deep reflection for me to realize that many of the young men and women receiving the sacrament were the same children I had baptized years ago. The work of a priest, a shepherd, takes on a new and beautiful meaning when you witness the flock mature in life. We see them become good husbands and wives, dedicated parents, and even FOCUS missionaries. While it is sad when some leave the Faith, we always keep the hope that the formation they received—whether at St. Aloysius School, in our Religious Education program, or from the pulpit at Mass—will remain, like a seed buried in winter, waiting for the spring.

It is a particular privilege to witness our young men and women discern their vocation. One of the primary charisms of the SJCP is to foster and help young men discern a possible calling to the priesthood. We are overjoyed that there are currently 8 young men from the Diocese of Madison (including 3 from our own pastorate!) studying at our branch of Shoreless Lake School in Spain. Our schools provide an integral human, spiritual, and academic formation where young people can discern whatever vocation God is calling them to. This Monday, Fr. James Kotch will travel with these 8 boys as they return to Spain for the new school year. Please join us in praying for their safe travel and for a fruitful year of study and growth.

We also ask for your special prayers for Ryan Webster.

Ryan is a young man from Wisconsin whom we met at St. Augustine University Parish years ago. He is beginning his theology studies this year in preparation for priestly ordination. God willing, he will be the first priest from Wisconsin ordained in the Society of Jesus Christ the Priest!

This is the life of our pastorate family—a life we want to celebrate with you!

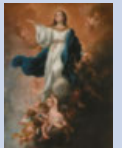

I hope you are all having a wonderful summer! As you know, my retreat/vacation to Spain is coming up and I will be gone between August 11 and September 12. Fr. Juan Diego will be covering most of my activities and Masses at St. Norbert, like he did last year. An occasional Mass might be celebrated by one of the other Society priests. I would also like to give you an update on the project that you may have seen in front of the RE Center building. With a view to beautify that section of the School entrance, and to make good use of a statue of Our Blessed Mother that we used to have outside on the lawn by the ramp, we have decided to build a stone patio and altar dedicated to Her. This project is being financed exclusively by several families of our parish who have made very generous donations, and will be dedicated in a special way to pray for the souls of those who have taken their own lives, and for those who are living and suffering from suicidal thoughts and depression. After completion of the project, we will have a special blessing for the patio and the statue. Details on the day and time of the blessing will be forthcoming. Our most heartfelt gratitude goes to the families who have contributed so generously to this worthy project.

A huge thank you also must go to our CCW! They have very generously donated (after consulting with the same company that is building the patio) to the building of a new retainer wall on the edge of the north lawn outside the church, close to where the new ramp has been built. The stone wall that was there previously was in bad shape, and the new retainer wall looks fantastic!

Finally, please remember that August 15 is the Feast of the Assumption and is therefore a Holy Day of Obligation, even though it falls on a Friday. Aside from the normal 8am Mass that will be offered in the morning at St. Norbert, we will also have a 7pm Mass on the evening of the same day as well.
