Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As I mark the 23rd anniversary of my priestly ordination, a flood of emotions washes over me. Above all, there is immense gratitude for the unmerited honor bestowed upon me to serve as a priest of Jesus Christ. I have never been able to fully grasp the magnitude of God's gift, nor understand fully why He deemed me worthy of such a profound and life-altering vocation.

From the moment of my ordination, I became irrevocably marked with the character of Christ Himself. The phrase "in persona Christi" (in the person of Christ) reminds me constantly of the sublime reality that a priest is not simply himself, but truly a unique extension of Christ in the world. Though an earthen vessel, flawed in my humanity, the hands I raise in blessing, the words I speak in absolution, and the sacrifice I offer at the altar are those of Our Lord. This truth never ceases to amaze and humble me.

Throughout the past two decades and more, I have experienced countless moments of joy, sorrow, triumph, and challenge alongside so many of you. I have baptized newborns, witnessed marriages, comforted the sick, and grieved with those who have lost loved ones. Your lives have immeasurably enriched mine. The people I have been privileged to encounter on this journey continually inspire me, reminding me of God's infinite love manifested in the hearts of His children.

A priest, however, is never self-sufficient. My primary mission is to be a channel, an instrument of God's boundless grace. In order to fulfill this mission, I am utterly dependent on your prayers. As a priest, I am also an intercessor – a bridge between your needs and the divine mercy of God. Please pray for me, asking God that I may be a worthy and clear conduit of His blessings. Just as I hold you in my prayers, please hold me in yours.

Words seem inadequate to convey my gratitude to God for the precious gift of my vocation, and for you, the people He has entrusted to my care. I offer this simple prayer of thanksgiving for 23 years of grace, and humbly ask for the strength to continue serving with love, compassion, and an ever-deepening faith in our Lord and Savior.

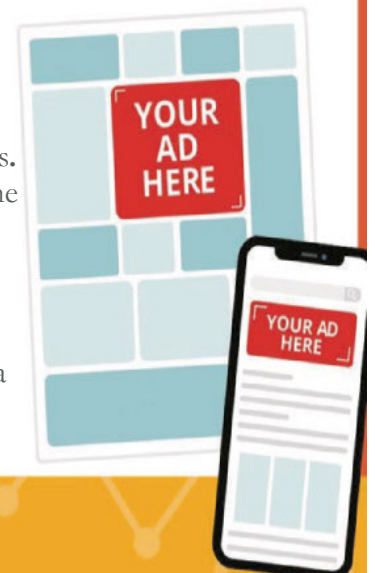

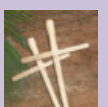

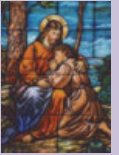
