

As we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord this weekend, we arrive at a significant liturgical bridge. 




Congrats to the winners of those. We are excited to see your hard work pay off in the BIG BEE next week!

3. Ecards are ready right away if paying by debit card or bank account. Paying by check takes longer.
