Dear Parishioners,

A joyful and heartfelt congratulations to all of our young men and women who received the Sacrament of Confirmation this past Tuesday! Through the laying on of hands and the anointing with Sacred Chrism, you have been sealed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit. You are now fully initiated ambassadors for Christ in a world that sorely needs your light. We pray that you continue to fan into flame the graces you received this week, standing tall as witnesses to the Gospel. Please keep our newly confirmed in your prayers as they step into this exciting next chapter of their faith journey.

As the spring and summer weather warms up, it is natural for our wardrobes to shift to lighter clothing. However, this seasonal shift offers us a beautiful opportunity to reflect on how we present ourselves in the house of God. One of the fruits of the Holy Spirit—which our Confirmation just received—is modesty. Modesty isn't about hiding away because the human body is bad; it is about protecting something incredibly sacred. As we navigate the warmer months, let's look at church attire through two important perspectives.

When we step into the church, we are not merely walking into a community center or a casual social gathering; we are stepping into the literal presence of the Living God. Jesus Christ is truly, substantially present in the Holy Eucharist—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Furthermore, every Mass is a direct participation in the heavenly liturgy and Christ's sacrifice on Calvary. Because our clothing is the external sign of our internal disposition, our attire should reflect this profound reality. Dressing with care, respect, and decorum serves as a direct act of love and adoration for our Lord.

We do not walk the path to Heaven alone. As members of the Communion of Saints and the mystical Body of Christ, what we do inevitably affects others, and we have a shared responsibility to help our brothers and sisters grow in holiness.

Because of original sin, humanity struggles with concupiscence, which is the inclination toward sin and disordered desires. This means the way we dress can either help others focus on God or become a source of distraction and temptation. Leading another person into temptation through immodest dress is known as giving scandal. While it is true that every individual is ultimately responsible for ruling over their own thoughts and eyes, we commit a sin ourselves if we willingly cooperate with temptation or carelessly become the stumbling block that trips someone else up. True Christian love demands that we look out for and protect one another.

To be absolutely clear, the Church does not teach that men and women should hide or be ashamed of their beauty.

God created the human body, and He called it very good. True modesty does not obscure beauty; rather, it reveals it. It ensures that our appearance reflects God's inherent beauty, rather than merely appealing to raw, sensual desires.

Our passions and desires are not inherently evil. They are powerful, God-given gifts that have a specific time, place, and holy purpose. Authentic masculinity and femininity are meant to be celebrated, provided they respect the profound dignity of the human person and bring glory to God.

This summer, let's challenge ourselves to make our church attire a reflection of our faith. Before leaving the house for Mass, we can take a moment to reflect on whether our outfit honors the dignity of God's house and shows genuine love and respect for our neighbors. Thank you for your cooperation, your reverence, and your commitment to making our pastorate a place of authentic holiness and beauty.

ST. ALOYSIUS CEMETERY RULES & REGULATIONS

Please respect the following rules for the safety of those who care for our cemetery:

- * Artificial flowers and arrangements are **not** allowed from May 15th thru November 1st. Any artificial flowers that remain after May 15th will be removed.
- * Please do **not** insert wire or anything on wire into the ground.
- * Seasonal flowers may be planted within 12 inches of the front or back of monuments. Please do **not** plant or place things on the **sides** of monuments.
- * Rose bushes, miniature rose bushes, ferns, shrubs, trees or any plants that tend to spread are **not** allowed.
- * Gravel or decorative stone for mulch is **not** allowed.
- * Brick, stone or any type of edging is **not** allowed
- * Vases, jars, or other objects made of glass or anything breakable are **not** allowed.
- * Bird houses, bird feeders and bird baths are **not** allowed.
- * One Plant stands/hangers/shepherd's hooks per monument. They must be removed before the ground freezes.
- * Everyone is responsible for their own planting, care and removal of plants.
- * **We kindly ask visitors to maintain a slow speed to ensure a peaceful environment.**

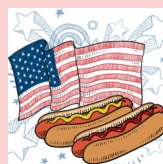
