Father James opened the meeting with a prayer.

Julianne read the minutes from the Thursday, March 24, 2022, meeting. Minutes were approved as read.

Finance Update

Transition of the banking accounts from BMO to Bank of Prairie du Sac in progress.

Buildings and Grounds:

Boiler motor recently failed and Hillestad has been contacted to get the new motors in. It was decided that since we have the motors on hand, we should replace them.

John Breunig has provided 3 speaker options as well as microphones which have been ordered and will be replaced soon.

Brian Breunig will be working on playground mulch in the next 2-3 weeks.

Mower maintenance has been completed and thank you to an anonymous donor who provided a push mower.

Willet Houser has been contacted regarding the stained-glass window which are to be starting soon, most work will be outside, and they can accommodate our Mass schedule.

Jerome Ballweg will complete stump removal as time allows. Thank you to Jerome for all his continued work on getting the trees removed and cleaned up.

Old Business:

Memorial Day Brat stand sign up sheets are posted. We need to get coverage on the volunteer shifts. Discussed happenings and logistics for the weekend.

First Communion was very nice and went very well.

Senior Mass will be Sunday, May 15, 2022.

Confirmation is Wednesday May 25, 2022 and gifts will be prepared.

Fellowship will be May 22, 2022. Mark Maier will be hosting. Fellowship will resume again in September.
