February 12, 2023

CCW President, Roxi Maier, called the meeting to order and invited all in attendance to start with a prayer.

CCW Secretary, Juanita Wipperfurth, read the January 8, 2023 meeting minutes. After a correction to the date of the February meeting the minutes were approved as read.

Fr. James stopped by and share that there are no new updates concerning the Into the Deep Initiative. We will know more by the end of February or beginning of March.

CCW Treasurer, Jeanne Walsh, shared the Treasurer's report. The expenses for January were to Rivers Edge Floral in Ace Hardware for flowers, St. Norbert's for the Renovation Project, MDCCW for the annual dues, and vigil lights. The income for January was from the money collected for the Vigil Light candles, vanilla, cookbooks, and poinsettia donations.

A motion was made and seconded to donate \$300 to the Good Neighbor Clinic, Prairie du Sac.

A motion was made and seconded to donate \$100 to the Madonna Plan.

A motion was made and seconded to donate \$100 for Water for Life.

A motion was made and seconded to donate \$100 to Vocation Purse Club.

The Madonna Plan, Water for Life and the Vocation Purse Club are all Service Projects sponsored by the National Council of Catholic Women. "The Madonna Plan has supported CRS' Child Survival Project in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, which works with pregnant women and women with children under age 5. Water for Life makes clean, safe water available to families. Program funds are used for integrated water systems that combine irrigation, sanitation systems and basic hygiene education. These all contribute to stronger communities. The NCCW's Vocation Purse Club helps support the needs of women discerning a religious vocation as a Catholic sister, nun, or member of a secular institute, including assisting the Vocation Fund in eliminating the obstacle of student debt."
